H.E. Msgr. Erkolano Lodu Tombe is the first Bishop of the youngest Diocese Yei in Southern Sudan, which was established in 1986. He will visit Austria to support the project to construct a new Church in the parish Lomin in Kajokeji County. This parish was opened in 1983 just at the start of the twenty-one year lasting civil war of the Sudan and was closed during 1987 to 1997. The civil war ended with the signing of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA) in 2005.
